

1. **Geneva General Hospital** signed and returned to the Department of ED the Certification and Agreement to receive funding under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. Geneva General Hospital intends to use, no less than 50% of the funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. **\$118,637.00** is the total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. **\$117,388.14** is the total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of 5/27/2020.
