First Semester Admissions

- 30% Dual Degree Students
- 10% Finger Lakes Health Sponsored Students
- 20% High School Students
- 40% Generic Students

Second Semester Admissions

- 50% MSWSPN Graduates
- 30 % Other LPNs
- 20% For students who have completed fundamentals of nursing within 2 years of application
